#### TOP TEN THINGS YOGI BERRA MIGHT SAY IF HE WERE A BRIDGE PLAYER:

- 10) Whenever dummy comes down with a distributional hand with hearts and diamonds: "Aha. Caught you red-handed."
- 9) If you are pair seven, when the opponents ask your number, "Well, we started out as seven, but we've been chopped down to six-and-a-half."
- 8) Always alert partner's bids of three no-trump, four of a major and five of a minor. When the opponents ask, say "forcing to game."
- 7) If you get away with that, then you can alert six-level bids and explain as forcing to slam.
- 6) On any flat board, where declarer makes the same number of tricks regardless of the lead, "Well if I led (anything else), we could have held them to (same number of tricks)
- 5) When you preempt and it is passed out and the dummy comes down, ask your partner why they bid so much.
- 4) Compliment your partner when they bid, defend or play a hand well. Then, remind them that last year around this time, they also bid, defended or played a hand well.
- 3) When the last hand of the event is completed, wish the opponents good luck on their next round.
- 2) When partner puts down their misbid hand as dummy, ask "What happened to the hand you held during the auction?"

And the number one thing Yogi Berra might say if he were a bridge player:

1) After bidding and making three no-trump, "I started with nine tricks—AND DIDN'T LOSE ANY IN THE PLAY!!!"

**Stratified**: A=2000+; B=750-2000; C=0-750 (Stratified by team or pair average)

**Strati-flighted**: Flights A/AX play together: A=5000+; AX=0-5000; Flights B/C/D play together: B=1250-2000; C=750-1250; D=0-750

**Knockouts**: Bracketed by average masterpoint holdings of all team members. Compact KOs limited to 4 members only. KOs may be handicapped.

## **Trophies**


Trophies awarded by the Denver Unit each year include the **Lou Neff Trophy** which goes to the Denver bridge unit player winning the most masterpoints at this Denver Regional Tournament.

The **Frank Thorwald Trophy** goes to the Denver Unit player beginning the regional tournament with fewer than 50 registered masterpoints and winning the most masterpoints in the Stratified 199'er events.

Novice Denver Unit players qualify for **The Denver Post Len Smith Award**, which goes each year to the player who begins the year with 0-20 points and wins the most masterpoints from all sources during the year.

The **Colorado Victory Trophy**, sponsored by the Denver bridge unit, goes each year to the Colorado player winning the most masterpoints for first through third in upper division championships at Colorado sectional tournaments.
