Rocky Mountain Bighorn Sheep—In this 100th year of the National Park Service, the Rocky Mountain Regional celebrates its namesake Rocky Mountain Bighorn Sheep. The Bighorn Sheep is found in every District 17 state and is the state animal of Colorado.

The males of these impressive animals weigh up to 300 pounds -- the horns alone can weigh 30 pounds. Males ram each other with their horns during rut, moving at up to 40 miles per hour. The noise of the collisions can be heard as far as a mile away!

Bighorn sheep have true horns that they retain throughout their lives (as opposed to antlers, which are shed every year). Herds estimated as high as 2 million once roamed North America, before crashing to the low thousands due to habitat loss, disease, and hunting. Numbers have slowly recovered and may be nearing 70,000 overall, although habitat loss and other human-caused threats are a continued challenge.

Much as the bison did for Native American tribes in the Great West, bighorn sheep were sources of food, clothing, and tools for tribes in the mountainous regions of the west. Petroglyphs featuring bighorns are among the most common images across all western U.S. states. Bighorn sheep were among the most admired animals of the [Apsaalooka](#) (Crow) people for their power, wisdom, sharp eyes, sure-footedness, great strength, and strong heart.

They are the symbol of Colorado's own Rocky Mountain National Park. If you visit the park in the summer, you have a good chance to see some of the 300-400 animals living there.

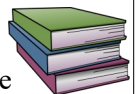
