In 2005, Denver will host a National Bridge Tournament (NABC). An organization separate from the Denver Unit Board will plan, organize and run the NABC. The Denver Unit Board's involvement is limited to organizing the National Tournament Co-Chairs and major committee chairpersons, who will then assume responsibilities for the National Tournament. The National Committee should be in place and working by 2002.

We feel the Committee should be thinking about and discussing ideas for hosting this tournament and the manpower required to do so.

One way to raise funds to finance this national tournament is through corporate sponsorships. The ACBL has provided information on this activity.

Sponsorship monies could be used for flyers, giveaway items, postage, rentals, signage, youth involvement, phones, etc.

Sponsors could be given the opportunity of having their logo printed on items, allowing them to display products in a booth, banners, etc.

The Committee must decide which companies to approach and who should give the sales pitch to them. The ACBL information is helpful in this regard.

The beauty of this idea is that to date we have never asked the community for money and we can show them the many tournaments we hold year after year and the impact it has on the community.

By implementing corporate sponsor-

ships, it will help reduce the amount of money we will need to raise through other fund-raising activities.

We feel a BRAINSTORMING/PLAN-NING meeting is beneficial as a first step in guaranteeing that the Denver NABC is one of the best ever. Topics may include, but should not be limited to:


- Recommendations for Tournament Co-Chairs and Committee Chairs

A Pretty Dummy Reversal



It's not perfect, but that's how the auction went. Plan the play.

With his strong spade holding, West should have led a trump, which would have ruined a good story. After the diamond lead, South ruffed in hand, played a trump to dummy, ruffed another diamond, returned to dummy with a trump and ruffed a third diamond in hand. Now declarer crossed to dummy by overtaking his J. with dummy's queen. He cashed dummy's A♥ and A♦, discarding the ♣AK from hand. Dummy's three clubs winners were taken, followed by a spade to the ace. South graciously conceded the final trick to West's K♠.

Tournament Directors have been instructed by Memphis to take the problem of slow play seriously. Many of the letters of complaint sent to the ACBL in Memphis deal with slow play. Therefore, we offer these suggestions:

- 1. Lead first, then do your bookkeeping.
- 2. Complete all boards in the round before you tell partner what he should have done.
- 3. If you haven't finished your boards before the round is called, North/South should move a board to the next table.
- 4. East/West pairs that have completed their boards should vacate their seats when the round is called. Don't continue sitting because the next chair isn't empty yet.

Reducing slow play will benefit everyone. Do your part.
