Unlike most pairs that win a national pairs event, Chuck and his partner for the event, John Moran, played infrequently and just happened to be available to play together due to not having clients for the days of the Blue Ribbon Pairs.

Chuck is the winner of hundreds of Regional and Sectional events and a multiple winner of the Colorado Victory Trophy awarded to the Colorado player that wins the most points at Front Range sectionals.

The bidding was a bit creative. Declarer didn't want to play in clubs, so he bid two no-trump rather than doubling two spades.

The lead was the "deceptive" fourth best heart which South won with the jack.

South cashed the ace of clubs, and then led a diamond. When West played the jack, south let him hold the trick. West shifted to a spade and East did his best by playing the jack, and letting South win the trick.

Declarer cashed his three good diamonds, ending in the dummy and cashed his king of clubs. When a club was played, the defense had the choice of which major suit to be end played. (a Winkle)


